## Jan Erasmus

Multiple award-winning graphic designer Jan Erasmus qualified at the Wits Technikon in 1975. After working in South Africa for two years, he left for the United States where he studied at the Philadelphia College of Art. He returned to South Africa in 1979 and has been active in graphic design practice since then.

Erasmus currently heads up Cyber Graphics, a design and DTP consultancy, which he also describes as a co-operative where designers may go to share personal expertise and utilities, as well as undertake joint projects. Cyber Graphics added a new dimension to its operations in June when it became the only design studio in South Africa to merchandise high-tech software, with the introduction of Emigre typefaces to the graphic design arena.

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


